

Important: When thoroughly dyeing candles with these dyes, always select one wick thickness bigger than the thickness specified in the catalogue! Do not heat wax that contains neon dyes above 80 °C!

Highly-concentrated grade, in the form of plaques, mixable. Quantity for overdipping: 10-15 g per kg wax*

Contrary to the case for the standard dyes, pigments offer 100% light stability and thus prevent any discolouration of stored candles. Pigments are only suitable for overdyeing or overdipping untreated white candles or candles coloured with aniline dye and must be thoroughly stirred 10 g bag € 3.50 50 g bag into the wax compound. If they are used to colour the actual candle, € 11.they will cause the wick to become blocked. Note:

With round wicks of thickness R3 or more, it is essential to observe the braiding direction. When cutting a wick off the reel, knot another loop straightaway – the outside end of the reel must always form the top of the candle.

How to establish the braiding direction:

When looking at the V-shaped braided structure on the flattened side of the round wick, the wider top of the V points towards the candle tip.

Pictures of the different reel sizes in our range are shown below, with a loop knotted on the outside end of the wick.

Precautionary measures

Due to the risk of fire, it is essential for wax (flash point 180 °C) to always be heated indirectly, i.e. in a double boiler or in a special melter with a safety thermostat. Wax should not be melted on a gas cooker in view of the naked flame.

Boiling water can cause serious injury. Where there is a risk of people tripping or falling, vessels that are full of water must be checked for their stability and secured, if necessary.

Wax-dyes and scented oils should not be kept with food and must be kept out of reach of children.

It is advisable to take out liability insurance for public events.

At public candle-dipping events, some 30 to 100 kg wax will be required at each melting point depending on the duration and scale of the event.

Instructions for Candle Dipping

- Place the wax in the melting pot and heat the pot to 70 73 °C in a bain-marie, Fig. 1. The temperature of the wax is decisive for achieving a smooth candle surface. Because of the risk of fire, never melt wax directly in a saucepan.
- 2. Stir in the desired wax dye (standard quality). Do not add too much: 1–2 g dye for 1 kg wax (to test the colour, pour some liquid wax into a bowl of cold water). Too much dye can adversely affect the way your candle burns. Dyes can be mixed with one another.
- 3. Decide on the diameter of the candle and select the appropriate wick. Knot a loop at the end (Fig. 2), which will also form the tip of the candle (observe the braiding direction on round wicks, see under "Note" on page 10 of the catalogue).
- 4. Dip the wick into the liquid wax up to about 1.5 cm below the loop, Fig. 3. The first dipping operation needs to last somewhat longer (approx. 5 seconds), to ensure that the wick fabric is fully impregnated. Hold the wick over the melting pot and let the excess wax drip off and pull the wick straight, Fig. 4.
- 5. The candle must be allowed to cool (to about 35 °C) after each dipping operation. To test the temperature, hold the candle against your cheek (if there is no perceptible temperature difference, the next dipping operation can commence). It is important to maintain a uniform rhythm during candle dipping: immerse swiftly wait a short time (approx. 1 second) remove swiftly drain cool immerse again, and so on. If the candle has cooled down completely due to work being interrupted, the next dipping operation should last somewhat longer (about 5 seconds).

Contrary to the case for beeswax candles, paraffin and paraffin/stearin candles can also be cooled in cold water (at approx. 20 $^{\circ}$ C) rather than in air. It is then important to dry the candles with a cotton or drying tissues (page 91) each time.

6. Once the candle has reached the desired diameter, cut off the wax hanging at the bottom of the candle while it is still warm, Fig. 5. Then roll the base of the candle at an angle of 45° while applying slight pressure, Fig. 6. After this, press the candle onto the work surface until it is standing straight. Cut off the loop in the wick before lighting the candle.

Important

Cover the work surface and wear an apron! Check the temperature of the wax with a thermometer that covers a range of 40 to 100 $^\circ\mathrm{C}.$

Warning

Dip candles only with adult supervision. Because of the danger of injury, a candle must be heated right through before being cut through its centre. Cold candles must be dipped an appropriate number of times (depending on their thickness) before being cut. Melting wax in a saucepan or over a naked flame is a fire hazard. Wax vapours can ignite at 180 °C. Never leave candles to burn unattended and always place on a fireproof base.











Instructions for Pouring Candles

- 1. Fill the wax melting pot with wax and heat indirectly to 80-90 °C (176–194 °F) in a pan of hot water, Fig. 1. The correct temperature is crucial if the candle is to have a smooth surface and is to be successfully released from the mould. Because of the risk of fire, never melt wax directly in a saucepan!
- 2. The desired colour shade will be obtained by stirring in the wax dye (standard quality). Mix with caution: 1–2 g dye for 1 kg wax (to test the colour, pour some liquid wax into a bowl of cold water). Too much dye can adversely affect the way your candle burns. Dyes can be mixed with one another.
- 3. The wick must be the right size for the diameter of the mould. With noncylindrical shapes, take the average diameter as the standard.
- 4. Tie a double knot at the end of the wick, Fig. 2, and trim to the required length; a slanting cut will make it easier to insert the wick into the mould. Insert the wick from the tip and secure it with the enclosed needle at the other end of the mould (pierce wick with needle), Fig. 3. Make sure that the double knot fully seals the opening in the neck of the mould.
- Fill the mould with liquid wax, Fig. 4. As the wax cools a crater will form; to fill it, pour more wax in as necessary. For moulding in layers, Figs. 5 and 6, the mould can be tilted (using a stand, see page 49, or a bed of sand).
- 6. When the wax has cooled completely, cut off the knot at the candle tip. Following this, the candle can be removed from the mould. If the candle proves difficult to release, placing it in a refrigerator for a short time can help.

Important

Cover the work surface and wear an apron! Make sure the mould is clean and dry beforehand. Apply only as much of one colour shade as you are going to work with. Check the temperature of the wax with a thermometer. Clean out the mould with hot water and then wipe with a dry cloth or kitchen tissue.

Warning

Pour candles only with adult supervision. Melting wax directly in a saucepan or over a naked flame is a fire hazard. Wax vapours can ignite at $180 \,^{\circ}\text{C}$ (356 °F). Never leave candles to burn unattended and always place on a fireproof base.



Instructions for Moulding Soap

- 1. Preparations: cut the block of soap into small pieces, Fig. 1
- 2. Melting in a double boiler: place the pieces of soap in a heat-resistant pot (such as a soap melting pot) and heat to 60 °C (140 °F) in hot water, Fig. 2. Caution: if the soap becomes too hot, it can discolour. Soap must never be melted directly in a saucepan on account of the risk of fire.

Melting in a microwave oven: place the pieces of soap in a heat-resistant pot suitable for a microwave oven (caution: do not use a metal pot) and heat for 20 seconds at the highest setting. Check whether the soap is liquid. If not, then put the pot back into the microwave and heat for a further 5 seconds at a time until the pieces of soap have liquefied (caution: soap heats up within a matter of seconds in the microwave. Overheating can cause the soap to discolour. Exceeding the heating period of 5 seconds will create a fire risk!).

- 3. **Colouring:** a colourless soap can be given the desired colour by adding and melting soap colour stick (approximately 5 seconds in the microwave). Approximately 4 cm (1¹/2") of colour stick should be used for 1 kg (2 lb 4 oz) of soap respectively 1 colour stick for 200 g (7 oz) of soap (colour test: pour a little liquid soap onto a sheet of white paper). The colours can be mixed with each other.
- 4. **Perfuming:** add the desired special perfumed oil for soap (do not use any other perfumed oils!) and stir in carefully (rough stirring will lead to air bubbles). Add 10–15 ml (2/5–3/5 fl. oz.) special perfumed oil to 1kg (2 lb 4 oz) soap. Note: in the soap-making set, the soap colour sticks are already perfumed.
- 5. Moulding: if a thin skin forms on the surface in the melting pot, then this should be carefully stirred into the liquid or moved away to the side. Now slowly pour the liquid soap into a heat-resistant plastic mould, Fig. 3. If you wish to include decorative objects in the soap, only half fill the mould to begin with using transparent soap. After waiting about 20 minutes put the objects in place and completely fill up the mould (use only heat-resistant items which will not irritate the skin and do not pose any risk of injury!).
- 6. **Removal from the mould:** once the soap has completely cooled down, it can be readily released from the mould, Fig. 4. If it proves impossible to remove the soap from the mould, then the mould should be placed in the fridge for a short time and, after this, a knife used to trace between the soap and the contour of the mould (at a depth of approximately 2mm (¹/10['])). After removal from the mould, the soap should be allowed to dry for at least 24 hours. The soap should be wrapped in cling film or cellophane for storage.



Important

Cover over the working surface. Make sure that the mould is clean and dry when you pour in the soap. Use hot water to clean moulds and melting pots.

Warning

Pour soaps only with adult supervision Melting soap directly in a saucepan or over a naked flame is a fire hazard. Soap vapour can ignite at temperatures above $180 \,^{\circ}\text{C}$ (356 $^{\circ}\text{F}$).

Transport damage

Any transport damage must be notified to the corresponding transport establishment without delay (post office, parcels service, railway, forwarding agent, etc.). We cannot supply free replacements if no claim has been submitted to the carrier.

Complaints, guarantee

Complaints regarding visible defects must be submitted within 14 days of receipt. Once this deadline has expired, the consignment is deemed to have been accepted.

Returned products will only be accepted after notification by telephone; they must be returned, post-paid, in transportproof packaging. We retain the right to charge either the full price or part of the price for damaged products that are no longer in their original condition when received. In the case of justified complaints, we undertake to repair the products concerned, provide replacements or reduce the bill. Other guarantee claims are excluded, insofar as legally permitted. The guarantee will cease to be valid if customers make changes or conduct repairs themselves or have this done by third parties without our agreement. No liability can be accepted for consequential damage.

Custom-made products

We cannot take back custom-made products or articles that we have purchased especially for customers.

Terms of payment

Our invoices must be paid within 30 days of the date of the invoice without any deductions. If the payment deadline is exceeded, default interest equivalent to the standard bank lending rate will be charged, without special notification being necessary to this effect.
